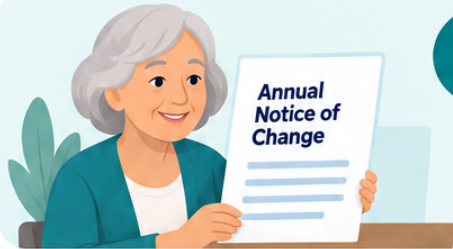

Read your fall notice

Your Annual Notice of Change explains next year's plan changes. Keep it with your coverage documents.

Recheck what matters

Doctors, hospitals, drugs, pharmacies and total costs. Your needs and your plan can change.

Know the fall window

October 15–December 7: review Medicare Advantage and Part D choices. Changes generally start January 1.

Make a deliberate choice

You do not have to switch. Confirm your plan is continuing and still fits. Medigap has separate enrollment rights.
